Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Bakhtiyarpur P.S. Case No. 270/2018 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341/323/324/326/307/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is case and counter case between the parties and they are closely related agnates and there is history of land dispute. It is further submitted that both the sides had sustained injuries and the petitioners are not having any criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioners above named be released on



bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. 1st, Barh, Patna, in connection with Bakhtiyarpur P.S. Case No. 270/2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
