4. From the same, it transpires that the interest as was required in terms of the Full Bench decision of this Court in **Ram Gulam vs. State of Bihar** reported as **2015 (1) PLJR 568** has been credited into the account of the petitioner on 21.09.2019 to the tune of Rs. 99,847/-.

5. In the aforesaid background, the Court finds that the order dated 23.05.2017 passed in CWJC No. 19119 of 2014, stands complied.
