2 13-05-2019 Petitioners are permitted to make necessary correction in paragraph 6 of the bail petition.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 152, 186, 341, 323, 353, 427 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act.

Submission is that in another criminal matter, the police was not taking any action, hence, the people had blocked the road traffic and for that reason, three cases were lodged against named and unknown. FIR is against unknown.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the



petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is pending in connection with Barhara Police Station Case No. 164 of 2018, subject to the condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
