ORAL ORDER

2 17-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since 21.03.2019 in a case for the offence registered under Sections 3, 4, 5 of Immoral Traffic Act, 30(a), 37(i) (ii) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that total 250 ML wine is said to have been recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Charge sheet/Prosecution report has been submitted in the present case. There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has



falsely been implicated in the present case. It is alleged that total 250 ML wine is recovered. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr. P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R/ Complaint Case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna, in connection with Special Case No. 3109 of 2019 (arising out of Rupaspur P.S. Case No. 159 of 2019).
