2 27-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Teghra P.S. Case No.476 of 2018 for the offences under Sections 25(1-b), 26 & 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since 19.12.2018. He further submits that the allegation against the petitioner is that the arms was kept beneath the seat of the car.

Case No.476 of 2018.
