2 16-05-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Mahua P.S. Case No. 219 of 2017, disclosing offences under Section 392 of the Indian Penal code and subsequently 412 has been added.

Prosecution case is that four miscreants came on the petrol pump, where the informant is Nozzle Man, and they taken away Rs. 1,36,000/- on the point of pistol and also damaged the CCTV installed at petrol pump. Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R., his name transpired on the confession of co-accused Sanjay Sah and confessional statement is also the part of F.I.R.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that save and except the confessional statement of co-accused,



there is nothing against the petitioner so as to show his involvement in the offence and though he is an accused in one more case but that is quite old.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail rather petitioner may move the court below for grant of regular bail and if any such application is filed, the court below will dispose of the same on the basis of material against him, if possible on same day, without being prejudiced by this order.

This application is, accordingly, disposed of.
