2 14-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are languishing in custody for the offences punishable under Sections 379/411/353/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Rule 4, 40 of the Bihar Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1972 and Rule 6 (4) 8 of the Bihar Minerals (Prevention of Illegal Mining Transportation and Storage) Rules 2003.

Allegation is of illegal mining of sand by the petitioners and others.



Considering the nature of allegation, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Ramgarh P.S. Case No. 83 of 2019, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below having immovable property.

(b) The petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
