Petitioner seeks bail in **Durgawati P.S. Case No.66 of 2019** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 413, 414, 420, 400, 401, 201, 216-A Indian Penal Code and Section 25(1-b)A, 26 of the Arms Act.

It is alleged in the written report that one Golu Singh @ Vinit was arrested and on his confessional statement the police made search at different places. It is alleged that one TVS Apache motorcycle has been recovered from possession of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that aforesaid motorcycle belongs to petitioner. He has referred to the report of



the DTO, Kaimur, which is enclosed as Annexure-2, from which it appears that seized vehicle stands in the name of the petitioner.

Petitioner is in custody since 09.03.2019.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaimur at Bhabhua**, in connection with **Durgawati P.S. Case No.66 of 2019**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
