learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 414, 467, 468, 471/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he had
kept two motorcycle on one registration number and one
motorcycle was recovered from the house of the petitioner.
Petitioner does not have any criminal antecedent. Moreover, one
co-accused namely, Bablu Kumar having, more or less, similar
allegation has already been granted privilege of bail by a co-
ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 09.05.2019 passed
in Cr. Misc. No. 30658 of 2019.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sasaram in connection with Chenari P.S. Case No. 50 of 2019.
