Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with G.R.P. Patna Junction P.S. Case No. 438/2017 registered for the offense punishable under Sections 406/419/420/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he has no role to play. It only because there was some dispute between the said Prem who was the friend of the informant that an unusual story has been concocted in which the petitioner has also been named. A perusal of the same reveals that the entire story is false and fabricated and has no connection with the present petitioner. The allegation is against Prem and not this petitioner.



In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned In-charge A.C.J.M., Railway, Patna, in connection with G.R.P. Patna Junction P.S. Case No. 438/2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
