2 16-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offences under Sections 363 and 364 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case in short is that the accused
persons forcibly abducted the son of the informant.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 4.10.2018 and has got no
criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of
witnesses alleged against the petitioner. Charge-sheet has been
submitted in the present case. The petitioner has falsely been
implicated in the present case. On recovery, the statement of the
victim has been recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C. in which he
has not named the petitioner.



On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R..

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Jamui in connection with Sikandra P.S. Case No. 222 of 2018.
