Petitioners are in custody in connection with Paraiya
P.S. Case No. 56 of 2019 for the offence under section 30(a) of
the Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
petitioner no.1 is lady and petitioner no.2 has no criminal
antecedent.

In the instant case 40 liters of mahua wine was seized.

Petitioners are in custody since 6.4.2019.

Considering the fact that petitioner no.1 is lady and
petitioner no.2 has no criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined



to grant bail to the petitioners, let the petitioners, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge Excise, Gaya, in connection with Paraiya P.S. Case No. 56 of 2019.
