2 22-05-2019 Heard both sides.

The petitioners apprehend their arrest in Complaint case No. C-1/128/18 for the offences allegedly committed by the petitioners under Section 498A of the IPC.

The complainant made allegation of demand of dowry and torture against her husband and other in-laws. The petitioners are father-in-law, mother-in-law and brother-in-law of the complainant.



The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are ready to keep the complainant.

Considering the facts aforesaid and nature of allegation made against the petitioners and the fact that petitioners are in-laws of the complainant, the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest/ surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/ production of a copy of this order are directed to be enlarged on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub divisional Judicial Magistrate, Pupari, Sitamarhi in connection with Complaint case No. C-1/128/18, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
