for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act, 2016.

7 liters of country made liquor is said to have been
recovered from the possession of the petitioner.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
no incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious
physical possession of the petitioner. He has no concern with the
seized liquor. He has been falsely implicated in the case at the
instance of his enemies by planting the aforesaid recovery from
his possession. There is violation of Section 100 Cr.P.C. He has



no criminal antecedent. He has been languishing in custody since 17.03.2019.

Learned APP for the State opposed the bail petition.

Considering the facts aforesaid, the above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge-cum- ADJ-IV, Kaimur at Bhabua in connection with Excise Case No.206 of 2019, arising out of Adoura P.S. Case No.14 of 2019.
