The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in connection with Kahalgoan (Ghogha)) P.S. Case No.07 of 2019 for allegedly having committed the offence under Sections 341, 323, 504, 324, 307 and 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the entire case is false and frivolous and no specific role has been attributed to the present petitioners.

Case No.07 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
