2 20-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the
learned counsel for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in
connection with Excise Case No.350 of 2019 for allegedly
having committed the offence under Section 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
the alleged recoveries and the seizure list do not indicate the
exact place of recovery and as such, there is a distinct cloud
on the prosecution story.

In view of such facts and circumstances, let both
the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or



surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 9th Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge, Excise, Motihari, East Champaran, in connection with Excise Case No.350 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
