2 27-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the

counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Kotwali (Tikamanjhi) P.S. Case No. 216 of 2019 for the
offences under Sections 399, 402 of the Indian Penal Code and
Section 25(1-b)A, 26(ii) and 35 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
20.03.2019. He further submits that in the instant case nine
persons were named accused. It is alleged that they were staying
at Shish Mahal Hotel in order to commit crime. From the room
of the hotel one country made pistol with live cartridges were
recovered from the possession of the petitioner.



Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in connection with Kotwali (Tikamanjhi) P.S. Case No. 216 of 2019.
