2 04-06-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody for the
offences punishable under Sections 385/387/307/34 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

It appears that having identical allegation co-accused
Sumit Kumar and Vivek Rai have already been allowed bail by a
coordinate Bench of this Court in Cr. Misc. No.21548 of 2019
and Cr. Misc. No.32232 of 2019. The FIR is against unknown.

Hence, let the petitioner, above named, be released on
bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand)
with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of
the learned Court-below where the case is pending in



connection with Danapur P.S. Case No.439 of 2018, with following conditions:

(a) Both the bailors shall be the resident of territorial jurisdiction of the learned Court-below having immovable property in his name.

(b) The petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
