2 27-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with Riga
P.S. Case No. 221 of 2017 for the offences under Sections 420,
406, 409 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in custody since
10.04.2019. He further submits that in the instant case the main
accused the Chairman of PACS has already been granted bail.
He further submits that entire amount i.e. the price of the rice
has been deposited and as such petitioner deserve bail.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal
antecedent and the Chairmant of the PACS has already been



granted bail, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Sitamarhi in connection with Riga P.S. Case No. 221 of 2017.
