learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Narpatganj (Basmatiya) P.S. Case No. 118 of 2018
registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 325, 333,
353, 379, 188, 427, 504, 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner submits that similarly situated several co-accused
persons have already been allowed bail by a Bench of this Court
vide Cr. Misc. No. 35737 of 2018 on 19.07.2018.

within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail
