The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Palasi P.S.
Case No.322 of 2018 registered under Sections 341, 323, 498A,
504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is husband and he is ready to keep his wife.

Considering the willingness of the petitioner to keep
his wife, the above named petitioner is directed to surrender in
the court below within four weeks from the date of
receipt/production of a copy of this order and the court below
shall enlarge the petitioner on provisional bail for **four** months,
on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the



like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Araria in connection with Palasi P.S. Case No.322 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C. and the court below shall make efforts for reconciliation between the husband and the wife. If the dispute is resolved and the petitioner keeps his wife properly, the provisional bail granted to the petitioner shall be confirmed and if the dispute is not resolved between the husband and the wife, the court below shall pass order in accordance with law on the provisional bail of petitioner immediately after lapse of four months.
