2 03-06-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 38(1) and 41(1) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Petitioner is owner of the pickup van from which
1800 litres of liquor was recovered. Petitioner has got clean
antecedent.

Submission is that petitioner had no knowledge that
the driver was carrying the liquor on the vehicle.

Considering the facts of this case, let the petitioner,
above named, be released on bail **after completion of**
investigation on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees
Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to
the satisfaction of learned Court below where the case is



pending in connection with Spl. (Excise) Case No. 131 of 2019 arising out of Sour Bazar P.S. Case No. 76 of 2019, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner.
