Heard learned counsel for the petitioner; learned AC to GA 12 for the State and learned counsel for the Magadh University (hereinafter referred to as the 'University').

2. It is not disputed at the bar that the order dated 13.11.2013 passed in MJC No. 1839 of 2012 has been complied with.

3. In view thereof, the application stands disposed off.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be permitted to file representation, if any further dues remain.



5. Having regard to the aforesaid, the Court grants such liberty to the petitioner. If such a representation is filed before the Registrar of the University within four weeks from today, the same shall be considered and disposed off by a reasoned order within four weeks from filing of the representation.

6. If any further amount is found due and payable, the same shall also be paid to him within the next three weeks.
