ORAL ORDER

3 22-08-2019 Petitioner seeks bail in anticipation of his arrest in connection with G.O. Excise Case No. 827 of 2018, arising out of Kamtaul P.S. Case No. 260 of 2019 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 38 and 47 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Allegation is of recovery of 177.980 litres of liquor from a Tata Indica car of the petitioner.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has falsely been implicated and he was not present at the spot and co-accused had borrowed his car and he has no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned APP, who has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail stating that petitioner is owner of the vehicle and in FIR there is specific allegation against the petitioner that



he brought the liquor.

In view of above facts and circumstances, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. He may surrender and pray for regular bail.

With the above observation, this application is dismissed.
