ORAL ORDER

9 16-09-2019 The only issue involved in the present case is regarding grant of weightage to the petitioner herein in the matter of grant of pension as per Rule 74 of the Bihar Service Code, as amended vide Finance Department Memo No. PC-2-9-8/78/6190F, dated 27.04.1979, specially clause 8 thereof.

The learned counsel for the respondents has filed a counter affidavit on behalf of the Under Secretary, G.A.D., Bihar, wherein an order dated 04.09.2019, has been annexed which has been passed by the Additional Chief Secretary, General Administration Department, Bihar, Patna, wherein it has



been decided to grant weightage in the pension as per the Finance Department Notification No. 6190 dated 27.04.1979.

Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel for the parties, I deem it fit and proper to dispose off the writ petition with a direction to the respondents to grant the weightage in pension, as has been decided vide Finance Department Notification dated 27.04.1979, and accordingly, pay the arrears within a period of four weeks by revising the pension, failing which the respondent no. 2 shall not draw his salary.
