4 28-01-2019 After some argument Mr. P. K. Sahi, learned Senior Counsel representing the petitioner submits that in the changed facts and circumstances of the case whereunder now it is stated that routes have been finalized and formulated and a notification in this regard has already been issued, he may be permitted to withdraw this application with liberty to pursue his remedy if any available to him in accordance with law.

This application is, thus, disposed off with the liberty aforesaid. All the interlocutory applications are also disposed off

The apprehension of the learned counsel for the respondents or the intervenor that despite disposal of writ application specific order with regard to vacation of the status quo be passed is uncalled for and misplaced as with the disposal of the writ application all interim orders merges with the same.
