2 27-06-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

Petitioner is in custody in connection with G.O. Case
No. 367 of 2019 arising out of L.N.M.U. P.S. Case No. 94 of
2019 for the offence under section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act and Section 272, 273 and 34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

In the instant case total 67 liters of nepali wine was
seized.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner is in custody since 04.04.2019 and nothing was



recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that petitioner has no criminal antecedent, the Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, let the petitioner, named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-cum-Special Judge (Excise Act), Darbhanga, in connection with G.O. Case No. 367 of 2019 arising out of L.N.M.U. P.S. Case No. 94 of 2019.
