Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Sangrampur P.S. Case No. 55 of 2015
registered for offence punishable under section 366 (A)/34 of
the Indian Penal Code.

It has been alleged that Switee Kumari daughter of
Prabhat Pandey was taken away by Prem Kumar Pandey,
Abhay Kumar Pandey and Nema Devi for the purpose of
marriage and later on it transpired that they have taken away
her to Mumbai. The age of the daughter of informant has been
informed as 16 years. The statement of the daughter of



informant has been recorded under section 164 Cr.PC where she has stated that she is aged about 19 years and on her own volition, she had gone with Prem Kumar Pandey and she has shown her desirous to live with Prem Kumar Pandey.

Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, the prayer for bail of the petitioners is allowed and they, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks from today, are directed to be enlarged on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, XIV, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Sangrampur P.S. Case No. 55 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438 Cr. PC and also subject to the condition that one of the bailors of the petitioners shall be a local person having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the concerned Court. The petitioners will not induce any witness or tamper with the evidence. The petitioners shall cooperate in the disposal of trial and make themselves available as and when required by the court.
