2 28-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since 28.03.2019 in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 290 of the I.P.C. and Section 37(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is alleged that the petitioner was creating nuisance after consuming liquor.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has maliciously been framed in the present case and he has not been put on breath analyzer test. It is further submitted that though the petitioner is accused in one other case of similar nature, but he has been granted bail in that case.



Learned APP for the State submits that the petitioner was creating nuisance after consuming liquor.

Considering the nature of accusation and the fact that the petitioner was not put on breath analyzer test, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Patna in connection with Special Case No. 3380 of 2019, arising out of Sachivalaya P.S. Case No. 93 of 2019.
