learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner is in custody in connection with
Harsidhi P.S. Case No. 87 of 2019 for the offenses under
Sections 414/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he was
involved in the trade of stealing motorcycle.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has no criminal antecedent. The petitioner is in
custody since 17.3.2019. Nothing incriminating was recovered
from the conscious possession of the petitioner.

Considering the fact that the petitioner has no
criminal antecedent and nothing incriminating was recovered
from the conscious possession of the petitioner, the Court is



inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Let the petitioner, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with Harsidhi P.S. Case No. 87 of 2019.
