Petitioner seeks bail in **Jehanabad P.S. Case No.322
of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 302, 201/34
Indian Penal Code pending in the Court of the **Chief Judicial
Magistrate, Jehanabad.**

Petitioner is husband of the deceased.

In the written report, it is alleged that this petitioner
committed torture with daughter of the informant for demand of
dowry. He committed her murder by administering poison along
with other accused persons. He was attempting to dispose off
the dead body.

Counsel for petitioner submits that trial has begun.

The brother of the deceased has already been examined.



Petitioner is in custody since 05.0-5.2018

In such circumstances, this Court is not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

Prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is **rejected at this stage.**

The trial Court is directed to expedite the trial and make all efforts to conclude the same as early as possible, preferably, within a period of six months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

The petitioner may renew prayer for bail in the event trial is not concluded within aforesaid period.
