2 28-05-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since
20.11.2018 in a case registered for the offences punishable
under Sections 25(1-B)a/25(1-AA)/26/35 of the Arms Act.

It is alleged that from the possession of the petitioner
four live cartridges were recovered.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedent,
statement to that effect has been made in paragraph 3 of the
petition and the investigation has already been concluded.

Learned APP submits that the recovery of four live
cartridges were made from possession of the petitioner.

Considering the nature of recovery and statement



being made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedent, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.- 2nd , West Muzaffarpur in connection with Kathaiya P.S. Case No. 296 of 2018.
