ORAL ORDER

5 04-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, the State
and perused the case diary.

Petitioners, father-in-law and husband of the deceased
respectively, apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the
offence under sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Informant alleges that the petitioners and their family
members were in habit of demanding dowry and on non-
fulfilment of the same, they started subjecting his daughter to
cruelty and finally they killed her at the matrimonial house by
administering her poison.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
informant's daughter died of snake bite and the parties have
compromised the matter.

In the facts of the case as well as on consideration of



the allegation that the victim died in suspicious circumstance at her matrimonial house within three years of her marriage, prayer for bail of the petitioners is rejected with direction to surrender and seek regular bail within six weeks, which would be disposed of on its own merit without prejudice.
