ORAL ORDER

2 11-07-2019 An order, dated 15.02.2019, passed by the learned Additional Collector, East Champaran at Motihari, in Mutation Case No. 19 of 2016-17 is under challenge in the present writ application. There is no dispute that the petitioner has statutory remedy against the said order by making an application before the Bihar Land Tribunal, which he has not availed.

This application is, thus, disposed of with a liberty to the petitioner to approach the appropriate forum by making an application in accordance with law. If such application is filed
