 Having regard to the consensus arrived between the learned counsel for the respective parties, the present writ petition is disposed off in terms of the aforesaid judgment dated 27.09.2016 passed in L.P.A. No. 1699 of 2013 (*Kranti Kanak*



&Anr. Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.) and the respondent no. 6 is directed to consider the case of the petitioners and in case, it is found that the petitioners are similarly situated, the same relief as has been granted to the appellants of the aforesaid case, shall also be granted to the petitioners herein.
