counsel for the State.

Despite repeated calls, none appears on behalf of the
opposite party no.2

The petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in connection with
Mahila P.S. Case No.22 of 2019 registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 498A, 341, 323 read with 34 of the
Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry
Prohibition Act.

Considering the nature of allegation as also the plea of
innocence taken by the petitioner, in the event of arrest or
surrender in the court below within a period of six weeks, he is



directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nalanda at Biharsharif in connection with Mahila P.S. Case No.22 of 2019 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
