Petitioners seek bail in **Special Excise Case No.3438 of 2019 arising out of Barh P.S. case No.163 of 2019** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 147, 148, 149, 307, 353, 120-B and 323 Indian Penal Code, Sections 25(1-b)A, 26, 27 and 35 of the Arms Act, Section 30-A, 38, 41 of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise (Amendment) Act, 2016.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that there is no recovery of any firearm from possession of the petitioners.

From the seizure list, it appears that 25 litres foreign liquor has been recovered from possession of petitioner No.1 and 18.75 litres foreign liquor has been recovered from



possession of petitioner No.2.

Petitioners are in custody since 29.03.2019 having clean antecedents.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioners for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Special Judge, Excise, Patna**, in connection with **Special Excise Case No.3438 of 2019 arising out of Barh P.S. case No.163 of 2019** , subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioners.
