4 06-09-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Keseriya P. S. Case No. 163 of 2019, disclosing offences under Sections 272 and 273 of IPC and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Allegation of recovery of huge quantity of liquor from the house of the co-accused and petitioner was named as supplier of the same.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has falsely been implicated in this case, having no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned A.P.P. also, who has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner. In spite of case diary is available, he could not bring anything against the petitioner, except allegation in F.I.R. as stated above.



Having heard both sides, considering the above submission, this application is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within two weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount to the satisfaction of learned 09th Additional Sessions Judge-cum- Special Judge, Excise, East Champaran, Motihari, in connection with Keseriya P. S. Case No. 163 of 2019,, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
