3 13-08-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 30 (a), 41 (I) and 41 (II) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner, it is recovered from outside of the house. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten



thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Khanpur P.S. Case No. 31 of 2019 to the satisfaction of the learned Addl. Sessions Judge-II cum Special Judge Excise, Samastipur, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
