ORAL ORDER**

3 18-06-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since 06.03.2019 in a case for the offence registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that total 1035 liters wine is said to have been recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. Charge sheet/prosecution report has been submitted in the present case. There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is alleged that total 1035 liters wine is recovered from the



premises of School in question. The School in question does not belong to the petitioner. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the same. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr. P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R/ Complaint Case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-IIInd-cum-Special Judge, Saran at Chapra, in connection with Janta Bazar P.S. Case No. 154 of 2018.
