The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in  
connection with Hayaghat P.S. Case No. 20 of 2019 for the

Case No. 20 of 2019, corresponding to G.R. No. 812/2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
