ORAL ORDER

4 01-10-2019 This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail in connection with Piar P.S. Case No.50 of 2019, disclosing offences under Sections 272 and 273 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

There is recovery of illicit liquor from the hut of one Mahesh Sahani and the villagers have disclosed that petitioner is residing in the hut.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that no recovery of liquor from the house of the petitioner and he has no criminal antecedent.

Heard learned A.P.P. also who has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail on the ground that the materials collected during the course of investigation disclosed that she is residing in that hut as renter and there is recovery from the hut.



Having heard both sides, in view of the facts and circumstances, as stated above, this application is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to surrender before the learned court below and pray for regular bail, which will be considered on its own merit and also considering the fact that petitioner is a lady and if possible, be disposed of on the same day.
