This petition has been filed for a premature release claiming remission. In Paragraph 4 of the affidavit filed by the State while referring to the judgment in the trial in which the petitioner had been convicted, it has been stated in Paragraph 7 that the petitioner has completed the mandatory actual custody period of 14 years and 20 years for the consideration of the claim of the petitioner by the Remission Board.



It is also submitted at the Bar that the Remission Board shall consider the said request on behalf of the petitioner in the next meeting.
