APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30 (A) of the Bihar Excise Prohibition Amendment Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner. As per FIR and seizure list liquor recovered from the tea shop at Belchhi Market of Sujit Kumar.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten



thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Laheri P.S. Case No. 187 of 2019 to the satisfaction of the learned IIIrd Additional District and Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge (Excise), Biharsharif, Nalanda, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
