3 20-06-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 379/411 of the Indian Penal Code.

The prosecution case in short is that the motorcycle of the
informant was found missing.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 07-04-2019. The name of the
petitioner has surfaced in this case on the basis of confessional
statement of co-accused. The stolen motorcycle is alleged to
have been recovered from the petitioner. The petitioner had no
knowloedge that the motorcycle in question is a stolen property.



The other co-accused with similar allegation has been granted bail by a coordinate bench of this court vide order dated 29-05-2019 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 35224 of 2019.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar in connection with Dumraon P.S. Case No. 134 of 2019.
