2 27-06-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, O.P. No. 2
and learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under
Sections 147, 148, 149, 341, 323, 325, 307 and 302 of the
Indian Penal Code and 27 of the Arms Act.

The prosecution case in brief is that while the informant's
brother forbade in constructing the toilet tank, the accused
persons assaulted him, as a result of which, he received injuries
and died in the way proceeding for treatment.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the
petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation
of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The
petitioner is in custody since 01-04-2019. The allegation of
assault has been made against co accuseds, namely, Manoj



Yadav, Pramod Yadav, Mantu Yadav, Vinod Yadav and Pintoo Yadav. No allegation of assault has been made against the petitioner. The petitioner, at best, is an order giver.

On behalf of the State and O.P. No. 2 , it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the Complaint Case/F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioner named above is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in connection with Jamhor P.S. Case No. 35 of 2019.
