Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

APP for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in **Chainpur P.S. Case No.229 of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 379/34 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that mere suspicion has been raised in the written report. There is no recovery of motorcycle from possession of the petitioner.

In the written report, it is alleged that motorcycle of the informant was stolen from Priya Clinic, Sangm Nagar Hata. The informant has alleged in the written report that he learnt that motorcycle has been stolen by the petitioner and other accused as named in the written report.

Petitioner is in custody since 09.04.2019.



In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, II, Bhabua, Kaimur**, in connection with **Chainpur P.S. Case No.229 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
