This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Mahila P.S. Case No. 68/18, disclosing offences under Sections 498A, 341, 323, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 /4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Prosecution case is that the informant was married with the petitioner on 19.06.2016 and she lived peacefully for three months, thereafter, the petitioner and other started demanding Rs. 4 lac as dowry and on refusal by the informant, she was assaulted at the hands of informant. Lastly the accused persons after snatching all her belongings ousted from the house.

Learned counsel for the petitioner drawn the attention of this court towards the impugned order showing that in the panchayati, the petitioner was ready to keep the informant but



she was not ready to live with the petitioner and entire allegation is false and concocted and he is ready to keep the informant with full honour and dignity.

Heard learned A.P.P. as well as learned counsel for the complainant. Learned counsel for the informant has submitted that the informant is also ready to live with the petitioner, if she is kept with full honour and dignity as a wife.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this application is disposed of with direction to the petitioner and the informant to appear before the concerned court below on 16.10.2019, and if the petitioner files a petition that he is ready to keep the informant with himself with full honour and dignity and if he is willing to take the informant with himself from the court below itself, the court below shall release the petitioner on provisional bail for a period of six months to his own satisfaction and in the meantime, the court below will watch the conduct of the parties by calling them in the fourth week of each month for a period of six months and after six months, if the court below is satisfied with the conduct of the parties specially the conduct of the petitioner as well as their matrimonial life, he will confirm the provisional bail of the petitioner otherwise, he is free to pass any order /



orders as he deems fit and proper including cancellation of bail
bonds of the petitioner.
