2 24-06-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is apprehending his arrest
in connection with Excise Case No. 936 of 2019 arising out of
Ara Nawada P.S. Case No. 330 of 2019 registered for offences
under sections 30(A) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act,
2016 of the Indian Penal Code.

The police has seized a pickup van standing in front
of the house of Vipul Singh and, on search, huge quantity of
English wine of different brands were recovered. The papers
were also found from the vehicle from which it was disclosed
that the present petitioner is the owner of the pickup van.

Looking to the recovery of huge quantity of liquor



as also the entire facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner, above named, is rejected.

If the petitioner surrenders before the court below within a period of four weeks from today and prays for bail, the court below will consider the same and pass orders in accordance with law without being prejudiced by this order.
