counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Rosera P.S. Case No. 59 of 2019 registered for offences under sections 290 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a), 37(c) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

In the present case, the police has recovered a bottle containing 375 ml of illegal wining kept in the Jhola of the petitioner.

Looking to the quantity of wine recovered as also the petitioner having no criminal antecedent, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, be



released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Sessions Judge- IInd cum Special Judge, Excise Act, Samastipur in connection with Rosera P.S. Case No. 59 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. as also subject to condition that whenever the police will call the petitioner for investigation/interrogation, he will remain present and if he would not present himself, the privilege of grant of anticipatory bail shall be deemed to have been canceled.
